Kayne has a number of Sub-Advisory Agreements (the "Agreements") in place with unaffiliated third-party investment advisers as well as with Virtus Investment

Advisers, Inc (“VIA”). Kayne is under common control with VIA. According to these various Agreements, the affiliated and non-affiliated investment advisers have delegated to Kayne the authority to manage the assets of certain clients of the Managers with full power to purchase and dispose the assets and exercise the voting rights of stock purchased for the client accounts.
