### EARLY WARNING REPORT ISSUED PURSUANT TO NATIONAL INSTRUMENT 62-103 – ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES OF INEO TECH CORP.

**VANCOUVER, BC.** – This news release is related to the securities of INEO Tech Corp. (“**INEO**” or the “**Company**”). David Wambeke (the “**Acquiror**”) announces that on December 23, 2025 he acquired 60,000,000 common shares in the capital of the Company (the “**Common Shares**”) at a price of C\$0.015 per Common Share pursuant to a non-brokered private placement completed by the Company for a total subscription price of \$900,000.00 (the “**Private Placement**”).

Immediately prior to the Private Placement, the Acquiror owned 310,000 Common Shares, representing 0.18% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Company on an undiluted basis. In addition, prior to the Private Placement, the Acquiror held no convertible securities of the Company.

Following the completion of the Private Placement, the Acquiror owned 60,310,000 Common Shares, representing approximately 18.57% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares on an undiluted basis.

The Acquiror acquired the Common Shares for investment purposes and the Acquiror intends to review its investment in the Company on a continuing basis. Depending upon a number of factors including market and other conditions, the Acquiror may from time to time increase or decrease his beneficial ownership, control, direction or economic exposure over securities of the Company.

The Acquiror is located in Edina, MN 55410 USA.
