Each Unit consists of one (1) common share in the capital stock of the Issuer (a “**Common Share**”) and one (1) common share purchase warrant (a “**Warrant**”). Each Warrant entitles the holder to purchase one (1) Common Share at a price of \$0.10 per Common Share until the date which is eighteen (18) months following the closing date of the offering, whereupon the Warrants will expire.

1.2 State the name of the market in which the transaction or other occurrence that triggered the requirement to file this report took place.

On July 20, 2020, ABC Capital Management Inc. (the “**Acquiror**”) acquired direct ownership of 1,250,000 Units of the Issuer pursuant to the closing of the first tranche (the “**First Tranche**”) of a non-brokered private placement of a combination of flow-through units (“**FT Units**”) and Units (the “**Offering**”). The Offering consists of the sale of up to \$500,000 worth of Units offered at C\$0.08 per Unit and up to \$500,000 worth of FT Units offered at C\$0.10 per FT Unit (inclusive of the Issuer’s over-allotment option for an additional 3,000,000 FT Units).

As a result of the Acquiror’s participation in the Issuer’s private placement, the Acquiror’s beneficial ownership, control or direction over Common Shares exceeds 10% of the then issued and outstanding Common Shares on a partially diluted basis.

On July 20, 2020, the Acquiror acquired director ownership of 1,250,000 Units of the Issuer pursuant to the Offering.

Prior to closing of the First Tranche of the Offering, the Acquiror owned Nil Common Shares, representing 0% of the Issuer’s issued and outstanding Common Shares on a partially diluted basis and 0% of the Issuer’s issued and outstanding Common Shares on a non-diluted basis.

Following the closing of the First Tranche of the Offering, the Acquiror holds 1,250,000 Common Shares, 1,250,000 Common Share purchase warrants, representing 11.20% of the Issuer’s issued and outstanding Common Shares on a partially diluted basis and 5.93% of the Issuer’s issued and outstanding Common Shares on a non-diluted basis.
