On October 15, 2025, the Acquiror acquired 50,000 common shares (the “**Common Shares**”) in the market at a purchase price of \$0.98 per Common Share.

On October 20, 2025, the Acquiror acquired 19,300 Common Shares in the market at a purchase price of \$1.0799 per Common Share.

On December 3, 2025, the Acquiror acquired 421,000 Common Shares at a purchase price of \$0.95 per Common Share in connection with the Issuer’s brokered private placement. The Common Shares were issued pursuant to the listed issuer financing exemption under Part 5A of National Instrument 45-106, as amended by Coordinated Blanket Order 45-935 (Exemptions from Certain Conditions of the Listed Issuer Financing Exemption).

Prior to the completion of the acquisitions set out in Item 2.2, the Acquiror owned 1,666,666 Common Shares and 1,666,666 Common Share purchase warrants representing approximately 8.47% of the Issuer's issued and outstanding on an undiluted basis and approximately 15.61% on a partially diluted basis. Following the completion of the Acquisition, the Acquiror beneficially owns and controls, an aggregate of 2,156,966 Common Shares and 1,666,666 Common Share purchase warrants representing approximately 8.94% of the Issuer's issued and outstanding on an undiluted basis and approximately 14.82% on a partially diluted basis.
