As of September 30, 2019, Goodman & Company, on behalf of investment funds managed by it, exercises control or direction over 42,028,714 common shares of Nextsource. These holdings represent an approximate 8.28% interest on an undiluted basis. Since our last report filed on April 10, 2019, Goodman & Company has disposed of 27,750,784 common shares of Nextsource which has decreased its securityholding percentage from 13.75% to 8.28% on an undiluted basis.
