Maverick disposed of an aggregate of 1,433,000 Shares as of April 30, 2018 at an average price of \$0.2265 per share through the facilities of the TSX.V (the

“Disposition”). As a result of the disposition, Maverick’s holdings in the Issuer was reduced from 29.40% of the issued shares to 22.72% of the issued Shares.
