On November 1, 2021, the Issuer completed an acquisition (the “**Acquisition**”) and a private placement (the “**Private Placement**”), whereby an aggregate of 58,749,998 common shares were issued, resulting in the dilution of percentage of shareholdings held by RESOC.

The obligation to file this report was triggered by dilution resulting from the issuance of common shares in respect of the Acquisition and the Private Placement.

Prior to completion of the Acquisition and the Private Placement, RESOC held 14,333,081 common shares of the Issuer, representing 10.6 per cent of the issued and outstanding common shares. Following completion of the Acquisition and the Private Placement, RESOC holds 15,999,747 common shares, representing approximately 7.5 per cent of the issued and outstanding common shares of the Issuer.

RESOC subscribed for 1,666,666 common shares at a price of £0.24 (approx. C\$0.42) per share, for total consideration of approximately C\$699,999.72.
