RBC DS and RBC PC USA are wholly-owned, indirect subsidiaries of Royal Bank of Canada ("RBC"), 200 Bay Street, P.O. Box 1, Royal Bank Plaza, Toronto, Ontario, M5J 2J5.

RBC DS and RBC PC USA are together, the "eligible institutional investor" or the "RBC DS Managed Accounts Program".

Throughout May 2023, the RBC DS Managed Accounts Program, on behalf of client accounts over which it has discretionary trading authority, disposed of 27,471,379 common shares of the Issuer, resulting in the RBC DS Managed Accounts Program having control or direction over approximately 4.75% of the issued and outstanding common shares of the Issuer.

Not applicable. The RBC DS Managed Accounts Program is relying on Part 5 of NI 62-103 and accordingly has not included securities owned or controlled by other business units ultimately owned by RBC.

Since the last report filed by the RBC DS Managed Accounts Program on December 9, 2022, there has been a net decrease of 28,264,138 common shares of the Issuer over which the RBC DS Managed Accounts Program has control or direction. This represents a net decrease of approximately 10.27% in the RBC DS Managed Accounts Program's securityholding percentage in the issued and outstanding common shares of the Issuer.

As at May 31, 2023, the RBC DS Managed Accounts Program, on behalf of client accounts over which it has discretionary trading authority, had control or direction over 13,084,676 common shares of the Issuer, representing approximately 4.75% of the issued and outstanding common shares of the Issuer.
