On March 7, 2019, the Acquiror sold through private sale a total of 13,333,333 common shares (the “**Shares**”) of the Issuer, at a price of \$0.15 per share, for an aggregate purchase price of \$1,999,999.95 (the “**Share Disposition**”).

Prior to completion of the Share Disposition, the Acquiror had ownership, control or direction of 13,333,333 common shares of the Issuer and 2,000,000 options, representing 18.45% of the issued and outstanding Shares on a non-diluted basis and 20.65% of the issued and outstanding shares on a partially diluted basis.

Following the completion of the Share Disposition, the Acquiror had ownership, control or direction of 0 common shares of the Issuer and 2,000,000 options, representing 0% of the issued and outstanding Shares on a non-diluted basis and 2.69% of the shares on a partially diluted basis.

As a result of the Share Disposition, there was a decrease in the Acquiror’s ownership, direction or control, by 18.45% of the Issuer’s issued and outstanding Shares on a non-diluted basis and 17.96% on a partially diluted basis.
