Subject: Change of auditors of Komet Resources Inc. (the “Company”)

Pursuant to National Instrument 51-102, this letter hereby provides a change of auditor notice as follows:

PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP, Québec, Québec resigned as the Company’s auditor, at the Company’s request on November 28th, 2019.

On November 28, 2019, the Company appointed RCGT of Montréal, Québec to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP, and to hold such position until the close of the next annual meeting of the shareholders of the Company.

The resignation of PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP and the appointment of RCGT LLP was considered and approved by the Board of Directors of the Company.

There were no modifications of opinion by PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP in the Auditor's reports of the two most recently completed fiscal years ended December 31, 2018 and 2017.

The Board of Directors of the Company is of the opinion that there were no reportable events as defined by National Instrument 51-102 which occurred in connection with the audit of the two most recently completed fiscal years or for any period subsequent to the most recently completed fiscal period for which an Auditor’s report was issued.
