On December 18, 2019, 2176423 Ontario acquired (the “**Acquisition**”) ownership of 2,967,000 flow-through Shares at a price of \$0.95 per Share. The Shares were purchased from the Corporation on a private placement basis. 2176423 Ontario is beneficially owned by Eric Sprott. This report is being filed because Mr. Sprott’s beneficial holdings of shares have decreased by more than 2% of outstanding Shares since the date of the last early warning report filing.

The 2,967,000 Shares represent a change in holdings of approximately 3.7% of the outstanding Shares on a non-diluted basis since the date of the last early warning report.

2176423 Ontario acquired ownership of the Shares. See item 2.2.

Prior to the Acquisition, Mr. Sprott beneficially owned 121,387,063 Shares and 2,500,000 Share purchase warrants representing approximately 21% of the then outstanding Shares on a non-diluted basis and approximately 21.3% on a partially diluted basis assuming the exercise of all warrants.

Mr. Sprott now beneficially owns 124,354,063 Shares and 2,500,000 warrants representing approximately 21.2% of the outstanding Shares on a non-diluted basis and approximately 21.5% on a partially diluted basis.

The flow-through Shares were acquired for investment purposes. Mr. Sprott has a long-term view of the investment and may acquire additional securities, including on the open market or through private acquisitions, or sell securities, including on the open market or through private dispositions, in the future depending on market conditions, reformulation of plans and/or other relevant factors. Mr. Sprott currently has no other plans or intentions that relate to, or would result in the matters listed in clauses (a) to (k), above. Depending on market conditions, general economic and industry conditions, the Corporation's business and financial condition and/or other relevant factors, Mr. Sprott may develop such plans or intentions in the future.

Item 6 – Agreements, Arrangements, Commitments or Understandings With Respect to Securities of the Reporting Issuer
