In connection with the implementation of the Plan on November 7, 2022, the Acquiror acquired 121,975,844 Common Shares owned by the former shareholders of the Issuer in consideration of the issuance of 0.2155 common shares of the Acquiror for each Common Share so acquired.

The Acquiror may dispose of the Common Shares in the future as circumstances or market conditions warrant.
