This report relates to the common shares (“**Common Shares**”) of American Eagle Gold Corp. (the “**Issuer**”). The address of the head office of the Issuer is Suite 1805, 55 University Avenue, Toronto, ON M5J 2H7.

On November 9, 2023, the Issuer completed the exercise of an option pursuant to a call option agreement dated October 11, 2022 between the Issuer and the Acquiror (the “**Call Option Agreement**”), whereby the Issuer acquired a 20% interest in the NAK Copper Gold porphyry project in British Columbia in exchange for the issuance of common shares of the Issuer in the amount of \$1,500,000 (the “**Acquisition**”). As consideration for the Acquisition, the Issuer issued a total of 6,976,744 common shares in the capital of the Issuer (“**Common Shares**”) at a price of \$0.215 per Common Share.

Pursuant to the Acquisition, the Acquiror acquired control and ownership over 6,976,744 Common Shares.

Immediately prior to closing the Acquisition, the Acquiror owned and exercised control or direction over 4,707,004 Common Shares, representing approximately 4.6% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares. Upon closing of the Acquisition, the Acquiror now holds a total of 11,683,748 Common Shares, amounting to 10.7% of the total issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer.

Pursuant to the Acquisition, the Acquiror acquired the Common Shares as compensation for the sale of the 20% interest in the NAK Copper Gold porphyry project in British Columbia pursuant to the terms of the Call Option Agreement. The 6,976,744 Common Shares were acquired by the Acquiror at a deemed price of \$0.215 per Common Share, based on calculations of the 15 day volume weighted average price of the Common Shares on the TSX Venture Exchange, for a total value of \$1,500,000.
