On June 10, 2024, Libra, on behalf of the portfolios of investment funds it manages, acquired 5,202,384 Common Shares of Westgate pursuant to a business combination transaction (**Transaction**) between Westgate and Grafton Ventures Energy Holdings Corp. (**Grafton**). Holders of Grafton common shares received 0.34433507 of Westgate Common Shares at a price of \$0.44 per Westgate Common Share. The Westgate Common Shares were listed with the TSX Venture Exchange under the symbol “WGT” on June 11, 2024.

As a result of the Transaction, Libra, on behalf of the portfolios of investment funds it manages, acquired and exercises control or direction over 5,202,384 Common Shares of Westgate which represent approximately 10.33% interest of the issued and outstanding shares of Westgate.
